AUTHORITY

- 1.1 The Regatta is a Singapore Sailing event, organized by ONE°15 Marina Club in conjunction with Nongsa Point Marina Resort.

RULES

2.1 The Regatta will be governed by the following;

- ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (2013-2016)
- International Rules for Preventing Collisions at Sea
- IRC 2014 Rule
- IRC Certificates are not required to be "Endorsed". This rule change IRC rule 8.5
- IRC rule 22.4.2 shall not apply. There will be no limitation on crew numbers or weight except as required for boats as one design, which shall comply with their class rule.
- Relevant One Design Class rule
- This Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

ADVERTISING

- 3.1 A boat and her crew shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20, Advertising Code. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all self-righting mono-hull keelboats, multihull yachts of the size and condition acceptable to the Organising Authority, SB20 and belonging to members of Singapore Sailing Federations' affiliated clubs or invited sailors of other yacht clubs. Participating Yachts will be divided into the following classes:

- A.** Class A (IRC A & B) – Yacht with a valid 2014 IRC Certificate and a TCC of 1.00 and higher.
- A.** Class B (IRC C) – Yacht with a valid 2014 IRC Certificate and a TCC of below 1.00.
- A.** Class C (Performance Handicap) – Yachts of a cruising nature not having recently held a handicap certificate under IRC, IOR, IRM, CHS, IMS or/and similar handicapping system. Yachts in this class will be assigned an arbitrary PY number by the handicapping committee at its sole discretion.
- A.** In assigning a yacht's PY number, the handicapping committee may consider any data or criteria it considers relevant, including without limitation the yacht's skipper and crew. It shall not be bound to apply PY numbers assigned to the yachts by any other handicapping committee of any yacht club or other authority. PY numbers assigned by the Handicapping Committee shall be final and shall not be subjected to appeal. It is the intention of the OC to give all PY boats an opportunity to be competitive.
- A.** Class D (One Design) – Any recognized one-design class, with minimum of 4 entries is received.
- A.** Class E (Cruising Multihulls) – Any recognized cruising multihull class, with minimum of 4 entries as received.

- 4.2 IRC Racing Class is open to all yachts holding a valid 2014 IRC Certificate. The original or certified true copy of the Certificate shall be presented for inspection at the Regatta Office during registration. No changes to a boat's TCC will be permitted after the final entry.

- 4.3 Application for entry must be made on the official entry form, together with a non-refundable entry fee, which is available from the Regatta Secretariat or from the official SSR website. All entries must be received by the Regatta Secretariat no later than 1800hrs on 26 December 2014.

ENTRY FEES

5.1 The following non-refundable entry fee, exclusive of GST, shall be paid in full by participants either by cash, credit card or cheque with the submission of the official entry form to the Regatta Secretariat.

5.2 The entry fees include complimentary berthing for the participating yachts, which will be offered at ONE°15 Marina from 20 January to 7 February 2015, and at NPMR from 27 to 30 January 2015.

6.4 In the interest of safety, the Race committee may at its discretions abandon any race.

SAILING INSTRUCTION

7.1 The sailing instructions will be available from 19 January 2015 on the official regatta website and from the Organizer. Full course details will be made available with the Sailing Instructions.

VENUE

8.1 The Regatta Office will be located at ONE°15 Marina during the registration period, from 10:00am – 5:00pm. The Official Regatta Notice Board will be the notice board located at the Regatta Office and marked "21st Singapore Straits Regatta, Official Notice Board". During the race days at Batam, the notice board will be located at the Nongsa Point Marina Resort.

SCORING

9.1 The low point scoring system, provided in Appendix A of ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing, will apply.

9.2 Minimum of 1 race to constitute a Regatta.

9.3 9 races are scheduled for the Regatta.

- A. When 9 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her 2 worst scores.
- A. From 5 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- A. When 4 or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

BERTHING

10.1 Complimentary berthing for the participating yachts will be offered at ONE°15 Marina from 20 January to 7 February 2015 and at NPMR from 27 to 30 January 2015.

10.2 Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the Race Committee.

11.1 Singapore marinas/club and Race Committee will transmit and receive on VHF Ch77. NPMR will transmit and receive on VHF Ch72.

When there are 3 to 4 entries – 2 prizes will be awarded

When there are 1 to 2 entries – 1 prize will be awarded

SAFETY

13.1 The Regatta will be conducted under ISAF Offshore Special Regulation Appendix L, Category 6. The Race Committee reserves the right to inspect any participating yachts at any time during the regatta to ensure compliance with this rule.

13.2 Skippers' briefing is scheduled at ONE°15 Marina Club on 27 January 2015 at 11:00am.

INTERNATIONAL JURY

14.1 A Jury will be appointed in accordance with the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing. Decisions of the Jury will be Final, as provided in Rule 70.5.

CIQP

15.1 Participating yachts must submit complete outbound immigration and port clearance documentation to the Regatta Secretariat at ONE°15 Marina on 30 January 2015 before 5:00pm. This applies to Self-Righting Mono-hull Keelboat only.

SAILING PERMIT

17.1 Participating yachts are responsible to acquire their own 'Green Book' and Sailing Permit to sail in Indonesian (Riau) waters, latest by 16 January 2015.

AIS/HARTS TRANSPONDER

18.1 As it is a requirement by the Maritime & Port Authority of Singapore, all participating yachts must carry onboard an AIS or HARTS transponder. Rental of transponders are available at ONE°15 Marina Club.

Please bring along the originals of the above documents for checking

21.2 Clearance and registration takes approximately 2 weeks from the date of submission of the application. Upon approval and registration with the INDONESIAN EMBASSY, a Sailing Registration Booklet (Green Booklet) will be issued.

21.3 The holder of a valid Sailing Registration Booklet is eligible to apply for a Single Entry or 6 or 12 months duration Multiple Re-entry Sailing Permit through Golden Image Services Pte Ltd.

21.4 The Sailing Registration Booklet is renewable upon expiry or upon transfer or change of ownership of the boat.

21.5 The Sailing Registration Booklet is subject always to the validity of the Boat Registration License and Insurance.

22. PROCEDURE FOR APPLICATION FOR SAILING PERMIT

22.1 Holders of valid Sailing Registration Booklet and valid Boat Registration License and Boat Insurance may obtain a single entry or 6 or 12 month multiple re-entries Sailing Permit from Golden Image Services Pte Ltd. (same as above)
