



ADDENDUM TO NOR

Addendum No. 1

SB20 Asia Pacific Championships 2015

The SB20 Asia Pacific Championships will be held in conjunction with Singapore Straits Regatta (SSR). The following insertions to the SSR NOR will apply for this purpose.

1. Rules

The SB20 Class Rules shall apply except that SB20 Class Rule C.5.1 (Mandatory Equipment) is modified to only include C.5.1 (4) (a non-floating line, minimum 30m long of not less than 8mm in diameter). With this change, these are herein referred to as the Class Rules.

Explanation; This change is to promote participation from the local SB20 fleet by reducing entry barriers and it reflects equipment carried for the local SB20 fleet's racing activities. The OA has the necessary race support, safety and first aid coverage in place during the regatta to address this point.

2. Eligibility and Entry

The SB20 Asia Pacific Championship is open to SB20s that comply with the Class Rules.

All boats entered must have a current Membership of the SB20 Class Association.

The Organising Authority reserves the right to refuse an entry from any SB20 considered unsuitable for the event.

3. Scoring

A minimum of 4 races is required to constitute the SB20 Asia Pacific Championships.

4. Schedule

Up to 4 races may be completed each day. *This alters the NOR schedule which shows 3 races per day.*

5. Measurement

All SB20 crews shall be weighed at registration in accordance with the Class Rules.

6. Courses

SB20 are intended to sail windward / leeward courses which will be described in the Sailing Instructions and explained at the Skipper's Briefing.

7. Prizes

Prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd places will be awarded for SB20 Asia Pacific Championships.
